Tuition:

\$25 for 30 minutes once a week

\$35 for 40 minutes once a week

<u>The first lesson</u> is a trial meet-and-greet experience and will be free of charge.

Following the trial lesson, payment method is cash, check or Venmo. There will be a \$15 fee for checks that bounce.

Rescheduling:

Lessons *can* be rescheduled at any time prior to the time of the lesson. Missed lessons without prior notification are under no obligation to be rescheduled and will not be refunded. Use discretion in inclement weather and *of course* feel free to call and reschedule. We will cancel for level 3 snow emergencies.

Any lesson canceled by the teacher will be rescheduled or refunded.

Recital:

Students are encouraged but *not required* to participate in a recital once a year at the church. Recital is *for fun* and a perfect opportunity for students to showcase favorite pieces and skills that they've learned. It's also a way to say thank you to all the parents and family members who have so generously given of their time and money.

Materials:

<u>All students</u> must bring their books with them to every lesson along with a small notebook to keep track of practicing assignments. Families can purchase lesson materials online from Amazon or Sheetmusic+ as we need them.

For guitar students, please bring your instrument, a pick, and your tuner with you to every lesson.

For pianists, it's important to have a full sized keyboard with pedal at home to practice on. Real pianos of course are ideal, but an electronic will also get the job done.

Church Sanctuary Policy:

Please no food or drink in the church sanctuary other than bottled water.

For everybody's safety and comfort, it is preferable for a parent or caregiver to stay near the church facility for the duration of the lesson. This is really just for everybody's assurance and well being.

Practicing:

Parents are encouraged to help with and monitor the student's practice habits. Try to establish certain days during the week and lay aside a particular time. At least five days is best to facilitate a smooth lesson. *Note:* your lesson time <u>does not</u> count as a practice.
